• As of April 18, The Technical Planning Committee has reviewed and approved more than 65 sanctioned USA (VSI) meets, 7 YMCA approved meets, 7 non-VSI meets held by another LSC, but in Virginia territory, 4 dual / tri / intrasquad meets, and several sanctioned time trials. For each meet invitation the Technical Planning Committee Chair closely analyzes the language of the meet, making sure that the content appropriately fits our VSI meet invitation templates. The meet fees are reviewed, adjusted if needed, and approved by the Tech. Planning Comm. Chair and the Admin. Vice Chair.

High School Swimming Official clinics will be posted within the next few weeks.
There will be at least one, and possibly two, clinics just committed to diving officiating.
VHSL extends thanks to the many VSI officials who assisted with high school swim / dive officiating this winter.

• Bylaws Revisions: Walter, Mary, and David will meet in the next 4 – 6 weeks to review the recommended VSI Bylaws revisions, based on national guidelines for LSC bylaws. David has compared the VSI Bylaws to the recommended USA-S LSC guidelines for bylaws, and made draft of the minimal revisions needed. Thanks to Mary and Walter for keeping the VSI ByLaws up to date over the last 6 years.
