	Entries must be submitted in short course yards times using Hy-Tek Team Manager and Commlink-2 software.
	Teams must submit entries via email.
	A Team Manager printout of entries must be included. Entry sheet with the name of the person to contact in case of questions must accompany the entries, regardless of how they are submitted.
	"No Time" (NT) entries will be accepted.
	11 & Over swimmers may enter a maximum of 3 Individual events per day. 10 & Under swimmers may enter 4 individual events per day.
	Relay teams must be designated A, B, C, etc., if more than one per club is entered per event.
	Entries will be processed in the order received and <u>accepted to</u> the greatest extent possible without exceeding the 4-hour/session timeline limit.
	The Meet Director reserves the right to limit entries in any events, if necessary, to prevent too lengthy a session. This may include combining heats and events, which actions may require reseeding.

	Relay events: Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 10th place.

	All events will be pre-seeded except:
SEEDING:	<ul> <li>Events #'s 13-16, 33-4, 39-40, 55-58, 73-74, 89-90,91-92, and 117-118 will require a positive check-in</li> </ul>
	Positive check-in for all events except #'s 91 and 92(1650) will close 30 minutes prior to the start of the session.
	1650 Positive Check-in will close at 9:00am on Sunday December 16 <sup>th</sup> .
	SWIMMERS FAILING TO POSITIVELY CHECK-IN WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SWIM THE EVENT.
	SWIMMERS WHO POSITIVELY CHECK-IN AND DO NOT SWIM THE EVENT; WILL BE BARRED FROM THEIR NEXT INDIVIDUAL EVENT.
	Events #'s: 91 and 92 (1650) will be swum fastest to slowest and alternating heats of girls and boys after the top 10 finals swimmers have been removed. Swimmer will have the option of swimming in the AM or PM
PENALTIES:	Penalties for entries using fraudulent and/or non-verifiable entry times:
	Swimmer shall be marked as exhibition for the event entered illegally and the event shall be re-scored and awarded.
	Club may be fined \$100 for each offense, and a record of such offenses shall be kept and published as part of the official meet results.
	<ul> <li>Clubs entering swimmers not legally registered with USA Swimming before the first day of the meet may be fined \$100 per swimmer in each event so entered.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>If the swimmer is representing a club in competition, the fine will be levied on the Club. If the swimmer is unattached, the fine will be levied on the swimmer.</li> </ul>
RULES:	The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply.
	<ul> <li>Any swimmers entered in the meet must be certified by a USAS member coach as being proficient in performing a racing dive or must start each race from within the water. If a swimmer is unaccompanied by a USAS member coach, the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian must assume responsibility for compliance with this requirement.</li> </ul>
	The overhead start procedure will be used for the all sessions.
	The scratch procedures listed in the current <i>USA Swimming Rules and Regulations</i> , Article 207.12.6, sections D and E only will be in effect and modified as follows: The scratch rule regarding finals will apply to both heats (final and consolation).
	Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. In addition, photography behind the blocks is not permitted.
	Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited.
	In accordance with VSI Policy, only those coaches who have current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet
	<ul> <li>Coaches with valid USA Swimming credentials but are unable to provide them upon request will be issued temporary credentials by the meet director</li> </ul>
