The 15-16 time standard will be used for 15 and older swimmers. 12 and younger swimmers will have no time qualifications. <br> - 2013-2016 NAG time standards are in effect. <br> - Age on June 19, 2015 will determine age for the entire meet. |

When unaccompanied by a member coach, swimmers or their legal guardian must ensure compliance with this requirement. <br> - The overhead and/or chase starts will be used for the all sessions at the discretion of the Meet Referee. <br> - The scratch procedures listed in the current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 207.11.6, sections D and E only will be in effect for all final heats. <br> - Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.
