	• The Meet Director reserves the right to use 10 lanes for competition should it become necessary to keep the sessions under 4 hours.						
	The Facility uses a Daktronics Automatic Timing System with a 10-lane scoreboard and Kiefer Wave Eater racing Lane Lines						
	• The competition course has not been certified in accordance with current <i>USA Swimming Rules</i> and <i>Regulations</i> , Article 104.2.2C(4).

	No on-deck USA Swimming athlete registration will be permitted.						
	All Swimmers can enter any event and swim in any relay in their Age Group.						
	Age on December 5, 2104 will determine the age for the entire meet.						
DISABILITY SWIMMERS:	Athletes with a disability are welcomed and shall provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director.						
	The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to the competition.						
FORMAT:	All Friday Events are Timed Finals						
	<ul> <li>All 13 &amp; over swimmers will swim in a preliminary Morning Session. The finals will be an Evening Session and consist of 3 heats per event.</li> </ul>						
	A Final – the fastest 8 swimmer regardless of Age						
	B Final – the fastest 8 remaining 13 & 14 year olds						
	C Final – the fastest 8 remaining 15 & over Swimmers						
	All Relays for the 13 & overs will be in the preliminary Morning Session.						
	All 12 & unders will swim in the Afternoon Session which will be a Timed Finals Session.						
WARM-UP:	Morning sessions: Warm-ups at 7:00 A.M.; competition starts at 8:00 A.M.						
	Afternoon sessions: Warm-ups: not before 12:00 P.M.; competition starts not before1:00 P.M.						
	• Evening Finals Session: Warm-ups: not before 5:00 P.M. competition starts not before 5:40 P.M						
	Friday Distance Sessions: Warm-ups: 5:30 P.M. competition starts at 6:10 P.M.						
	<ul> <li>Lane assignment and warm-up times for individual clubs will be posted on the Williamsburg Aquatic Club website (<u>www.swimwac.com</u>) no later than Tuesday December 2, 2014, and will also be emailed to the contact person of the participating clubs.</li> </ul>						
	<ul> <li>If the morning session runs late, afternoon warm-ups will begin immediately after the morning session ends.</li> </ul>						
ENTRIES:	DEADLINE FOR THE RECEIPT OF ENTRIES IS TUESDAY NOVEMBER 25. 2014.						

	Entries must be submitted in Short Course Yards times using Hy-Tek Team Manager and Commlink-2 software, or on a VSI master entry sheet.
	Teams submit entries via email.
	A Team Manager printout of entries must be included or the meet checklist/summary sheet with the name of the person to contact in case of questions must accompany the entries.
	Coach Time (CT) and "No Time" (NT) entries will be accepted for events in which a swimmer does not have a time of record. CT <u>must be slower than an "A" time</u> . All entry times other than CT must have been achieved in USA Swimming sanctioned, approved, or observed competition.
	• 12 & under Swimmers may enter a maximum of 4 individual events and 1 relay event per day.
	13 & over Swimmers may enter a maximum of 3 individual events and 1 relay event per day.
	<ul> <li>Relay teams must be designated A, B, C, etc., if more than one per club is entered per event.</li> </ul>
	Entries will be processed in the order received and <u>accepted to</u> the greatest extent possible without exceeding the 4-hour/session timeline limit.
	The Meet Director reserves the right to limit entries in any events, if necessary, to prevent too lengthy a session. This may include combining heats and events, which actions may require reseeding. This may include the use of Lane 9 as a competition lane. In this case there will be 1 lane available for continuous warm-up & warm-down. Relays may also be eliminated and fees returned if this is necessary.

	Deck entries will be accepted in the order received for swimmers already entered in the meet, to the extent that open lanes are available. No additional heats will be added. Deck entries must be submitted to the Meet Director for approval by the Referee.

	<ul> <li>13 &amp; Over events will be given separate awards for each of the three Heats at Finals.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Friday's Events will be given 1<sup>st</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> Place for each Age Group (13 &amp; 14) and (15 &amp; over).</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>10 &amp; unders will be given separate awards for (9 &amp; 10, 7 &amp; 8, and 6 &amp; unders).</li> </ul>
	Relay events: Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 8th Place
SEEDING:	On Friday all Events will require a Positive Check-in.
	On Saturday & Sunday all events, except #57 & #58 will be pre-seeded.
	Swimmers in the all sessions should report directly to the blocks for their events.
	Events #57 & #58 will require a Positive Check-in to swim.
	Positive Check in will close at 5:45 P.M. on Friday.
	Positive check-in will close at 8:00 A.M. on Sunday Morning (The end of Warm-ups).
	SWIMMERS FAILING TO POSITIVELY CHECK-IN WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SWIM THE EVENT.
PENALTIES:	Penalties for entries using fraudulent and/or non-verifiable entry times:
	Swimmer shall be marked as exhibition for the event swum illegally and the event shall be re-scored and awarded.

	<ul> <li>Club may be fined \$100 for each offense, and a record of such offenses shall be kept and published as part of the official meet results.</li> </ul>							
	Clubs entering swimmers not legally registered with USA Swimming before the first day of the meet may be fined \$100 per swimmer in each event(s) swum							
	If the swimmer is representing a club in competition, the fine will be levied on the Club. If the swimmer is unattached, the fine will be levied on the swimmer.							
	The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply.							
	<ul> <li>Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA-S member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.</li> </ul>							
	The overhead start procedure will be used for the all sessions at the discretion of the Referee							
	The scratch procedures listed in the current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 207.11.6, sections D and E only will be in effect and modified as follows: The scratch rule regarding finals will apply to all three heats of the Finals Sessions.							
	Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. In addition, photography behind the blocks is not permitted.							
	Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is prohibited.							
	In accordance with VSI Policy, only those coaches who have current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet							
	<ul> <li>Coaches who have valid USA Swimming credentials but who are unable to provide them upon request will be issued temporary credentials by the meet director</li> </ul>							
	<ul> <li>Coaches with expired or non-current credentials will be required to leave the deck area.</li> </ul>

SWIMMERS MUST STAY ON THE COMPETITION POOL DECK.</li> <li>The Adventure Pool side of the building WILL be available for seating on Saturday and Sunday.</li> </ul>
