ELIGIBILITY:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closed invitational for NOVA, RSA, and CUBU registered swimmers with 13-14 "A" times or faster. Teams outside of Virginia Swimming, Inc. LSC may have additional swimmers at the coaches' discretion. • All swimmers participating in this meet must be registered by the first day of the meet. • No on deck registration will be permitted. • 2005-2008 NAG top 16 based times are in effect. • Age on November 11, 2005 will determine age for the entire meet.
FORMAT:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All events will be timed finals. • The warm-up and meet start times are estimated; final lane assignment and warm-up times will be posted on the NOVA website and emailed to the participating clubs by Wednesday, November 9. • Friday pm session: Warm-ups at 6:00-6:45 pm; competition starts at 7:00 pm • Saturday and Sunday am sessions: 1st warm-up (NOVA) 6:45-7:30 am; 2nd warm-up (CUBU, RSA) 7:30-8:15 am; general warm-up 8:15-8:30 am; competition starts at 8:45 am. • Saturday pm session: 1st warm-up (NOVA) 3:00-3:45 pm; 2nd warm-up (CUBU, RSA) 3:45-4:30 pm; general warm-up 4:30-4:45; competition starts at 5:00 pm.
ENTRIES:	<p>DEADLINE FOR THE RECEIPT OF ENTRIES IS SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 6, 2005</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Entries must be submitted in short course yard times using Hy-Tek Team Manager and Commlink-2 software, or on a VSI master entry sheet. • Teams may submit entries as an e-mail attachment (preferred) or on a 3 ½" computer disk. • A Team Manager printout of entries must be included or the meet checklist/summary sheet with the name of the person to contact in case of questions must accompany the entries, regardless of how they are submitted. • All entry times must have been achieved in USA Swimming sanctioned, approved, or observed competition. • Swimmers may enter a maximum of 1 event on Friday evening, 3 individual events per session Saturday and Sunday, with a maximum of 5 events total on Saturday. • The Meet Director reserves the right to limit entries in any events, if necessary, to prevent too lengthy a session. FEES:	Individual events: \$3.50 Swimmer surcharge: \$2.00 per person <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checks should be made payable to: NOVA OF VA AQUATICS • Payment must be received by November 11, 2005 for email entries. Payment must be included with all mailed entries.
SEEDING:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All events will be pre-seeded, except the 500, 1000, and 1650 Free, which will be deck seeded.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The 500, 1000, and 1650 will require a positive check-in to swim. • Positive check-in will close 30 minutes prior to the start of the session. • SWIMMERS FAILING TO POSITIVELY CHECK-IN WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SWIM THE EVENT. • Deck entries will be accepted in the order received to the extent that open lanes are available. No additional heats will be added. Deck entries must be submitted to the Clerk-of-Course on the provided forms. • At the discretion of the meet referee, the 500, 1000, and 1650 Free may be run alternating girls/boys slowest to fastest.
PENALTIES:	<p>Penalties for entries using fraudulent and/or non-verifiable entry times:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Swimmer shall be disqualified from the event entered illegally and the event shall be re-scored and awarded. • Club may be fined \$100 for each offense, and a record of such offenses shall be kept and published as part of the official meet results. • Clubs entering swimmers not legally registered with United States Swimming by the first day of the meet may be fined \$100 per swimmer in each event so entered. • If the swimmer is representing a club in competition, the fine will be levied on the Club. If the swimmer is unattached, the fine will be levied on the swimmer.
RULES:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The 205 USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply. • In accordance with VSI Policy, only those coaches who display current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do not possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.
OFFICIALS:	<p>Meet Referee: Tom Elliott Phone: 804/360-5001 Email: telliott@courts.state.va.us</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Officials at all positions will be required for this meet. • Team Officials Chairpersons should submit the names and session availability of certified officials, as well as the names and session availability of trainees to Dennis Vaughan at dlvaughan@msn.com no later than November 9, 2005. • Officials meetings will be held in the hospitality room 30 minutes prior to the start of the meet.
SAFETY:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • VSI Safety and Warm-up procedures will be in effect • Marshals will be present throughout warm-ups and competition, and have the authority to remove, with the concurrence of the Meet Referee, any swimmer, coach, or club for the failure to follow the safety rules. • During the competition, swimmers must enter the warm-up lanes from the far end of the pool (opposite) the starting blocks), jumping in feet first.
TIMERS:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clubs may be required to provide timers. • The head timer will assign specific lanes prior to each session
GENERAL:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Heat sheets will be available for purchase • Bleacher seating for 280 • Hospitality room will be open to coaches and certified officials • The Virginia Swim Shop will be open for swimming accessories and shopping. • Swim bags should be placed under the seats • No glass containers, smoking or alcohol is permitted in the pool area.
PARKING:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The NOVA Aquatics Center has parking for 75 cars. • Additional parking is available in the lot next door, and in several lots one block east of the pool at the intersection of Gayton and Cambridge. • PLEASE DO NOT PARK AT THE APARTMENT BUILDING.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • SOUTH – 95 North to 64 West to the Gaskins Road South exit. Follow Gaskins Rd. south to Ridgefield Parkway (3rd light); turn right. Proceed on Ridgefield until you intersect with Gayton Rd. (4th light); turn left. NOVA Aquatics Center less than ½ mile on left. • NORTH – 95 South to 64 West to the Gaskins Road South exit. Then follow the directions above. • WEST – 64 East to the Short Pump/Broad Street 250 West exit. Follow Broad Street (250 West) to Pump Rd. Take a left at that light. Follow Pump Rd. to Ridgefield Parkway (3rd light); take a right. Follow Ridgefield to Gayton Rd. (2 lights); take a left on to Gayton. Pool is less than ½ mile on your left. • SOUTHSIDE – Take Chippenham Parkway North which will turn into Parham Rd. Follow Parham to Quioccasin/Gayton Rd. (Regency Mall on left); take a left at that light. Proceed for 4-5 miles. The pool will be on your right.
