	• Teams may submit entries as an e-mail attachment (preferred) or on a 3 ½" computer disk.			
	 A Team Manager printout of entries must be included or the meet checklist/summary sheet with the name, e-mail addresses, and phone number of the person to contact in case of questions, regardless of how they are submitted. 			
	Coaches Times (CT) will be accepted for events in which a swimmer does not have a time of record. CT may not exceed a "B" time. All entry times other than CT must have been achieved in USA Swimming sanctioned, approved, or observed competition.			
	"No Time" (NT) entries will not be accepted.			
	There is currently a 98 athlete limit (7 heats with two swimmers per lane) at this meet. Tide Swim Team, Inc. plans to use approximately 20 slots.			
	 Entries will be processed in the order received. This meet will be limited to a total of 98 swimmers.
