FACILITY:	10-lane 25-yard pool with Kieffer Wave eater lanes, Daktronics Automatic Timing System. 10 lanes will be used for competition with 2 warm-up/warm-down lanes available at all times in the adjacent pool located at the NOVA facility

ELIGIBILITY:	Open to all USA Swimming/VSI registered swimmers 13 to 18 years old.					
	Swimmers with two "A" times at any distance one each in different strokes including IM as the fifth stroke can swim any event offered in the A session.					
	Swimmers not qualified for the A session can swim any event offered in the BB/B/C session.					
	Swimmers may only swim relays in the session they are qualified to compete.					
	All swimmers participating in this meet must be registered by the first day of the meet.					
	No on deck registration will be permitted.					
	2005-2008 NAG top 16 based times are in effect.					
	Age on October 19, 2007 will determine age for the entire meet.					
DISABILITY SWIMMERS:	<ul> <li>Athletes with a disability are welcomed and shall provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director.</li> </ul>					
	The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to the competition.					
FORMAT:	All level swimmers swim Friday evening.					
	The 500 Free will be swum fastest to slowest.					
	• All swimmers with two "A" times, in different strokes, must swim on Saturday and Sunday					
	mornings.					
	All BB/B/C swimmers will swim Saturday and Sunday Afternoon.					
	All events will be timed finals.					
WARM-UPS:	Friday pm session: Warm-ups: 4:00pm; competition start: 5:15 pm					
	Morning sessions: Warm-ups: 7:00am; competition starts at 8:10am					
	Afternoon sessions:					
	o Saturday: Warm-ups at 12:15 pm; competition starts no earlier than 1:30 pm.					
	<ul> <li>Sunday: Warm-ups at 10:15 am: competition starts no earlier than 11:00 am.</li> </ul>					
	<ul> <li>Finalized warm-up times will depend on entries; final lane assignment and warm-up times for individual clubs will be emailed to the contact person of the participating clubs by Monday, October 15, 2007.</li> </ul>					
	If the morning session runs late, afternoon warm-ups will begin immediately after the morning session ends.					
ENTRIES:	DEADLINE FOR THE RECEIPT OF ENTRIES IS SUNDAY, OCTOBER 14, 2007					
	Entries must be submitted in short course yard times using Hy-Tek Team Manager and Commlink-2 software, or on a VSI master entry sheet.					
	• Teams may submit entries as an e-mail attachment (preferred) or on a 3 ½" computer disk.					
	A Team Manager printout of entries must be included or the meet checklist/summary sheet with the name, phone number, and email address of the person to contact in case of questions must accompany the entries, regardless of how they are submitted.					
	<ul> <li>Coaches Time (CT) and "No Time" (NT) entries will be accepted for events in which a swimmer</li> </ul>					

	does not have a time of record. CT may not exceed a "B" time. All entry times other than CT must have been achieved in USA Swimming sanctioned, approved, or observed competition
	Swimmers may enter one event on Friday evening, and a maximum of 3 <i>individual events</i> per day on Saturday and Sunday.
	Relay teams must be designated A, B, C, etc., if more than one per club is entered per event.
	Entries will be processed in the order received. This meet will be limited to a total of 250 swimmers per session.
	The Meet Director reserves the right to limit entries in any events, if necessary, to prevent too lengthy a session. This may include combining heats and events, which actions may require reseeding.

	IMPORTANT: If entries are sent via Express Mail/FedEx/Airborne/UPS/etc., please ensure that a signature is NOT required for delivery as this will delay the receipt of your entries.
FEES:	Individual events: \$3.00
	Relay events: \$12.00 Swimmer surcharge: \$2.00 per person (entered in the meet in any capacity)
	Checks should be made payable to: NOVA OF VA AQUATICS
	Payment must be received by October 16, 2007 for email entries. Payment must be included
	with all mailed entries.
AWARDS:	Failure to pay entry fees by this deadline could result in teams being barred from the meet.  Individual avector Dibb are will be averaged for first through eighth place.
AWARDS.	Individual events: Ribbons will be awarded for first through eighth place.  12.18 events will be given conserts awards for 12.14 and 15.18 age groups.
	13-18 events will be given separate awards for 13-14 and 15-18 age groups.  Policy events: Pibbana will be gwarded for first through 4th place.
SEEDING:	<ul> <li>Relay events: Ribbons will be awarded for first through 4th place.</li> <li>All events will be pre-seeded, except events #1-2 (13-18 400 IM) and 3, 4 (13-18 500 Free),</li> </ul>
SEEDING.	All events will be pre-seeded, except events #1-2 (13-18 400 IM) and 3, 4 (13-18 500 Free), which will be deck seeded.
	The 400 IM and the 500 Free will require a positive check-in to swim.
	Positive check-in will close 30 minutes prior to the start of the session.
	SWIMMERS FAILING TO POSITIVELY CHECK-IN WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SWIM THE EVENT.
	Swimmers in all sessions should report directly to the blocks for their events.
	Deck entries will be accepted in the order received to the extent that open lanes are available.  No additional heats will be added. Deck entries must be submitted to the Clerk-of-Course on the provided forms.
PENALTIES:	Penalties for entries using fraudulent and/or non-verifiable entry times:
	Swimmer shall be disqualified from the event entered illegally and the event shall be rescored and awarded.
	Club may be fined \$100 for each offense, and a record of such offenses shall be kept and published as part of the official meet results.
	Clubs entering swimmers not legally registered with United States Swimming by the first day of the meet may be fined \$100 per swimmer in each event so entered.
	If the swimmer is representing a club in competition, the fine will be levied on the Club. If the swimmer is unattached, the fine will be levied on the swimmer.
RULES:	The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply.
	The overhead start procedure will be used for the afternoon sessions, and may be used for the morning sessions at the discretion of the Referee.
	In accordance with VSI Policy, only those coaches who display current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do not possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

	Officials meetings will be held in the hospitality area 45 minutes prior to the start of the meet.						
SAFETY:	VSI Safety and Warm-up procedures will be in effect. Marshals will be present throughout warm-ups and competition, and have the authority to remove, with the concurrence of the Meet Referee, any swimmer, coach, or club for the failure to follow the safety rules.						
TIMERS:	Clubs will be required to provide timers and counters for the 500 Free. The head timer will assign specific lanes prior to each session.						
GENERAL:	Heat sheets will be available for purchase.						
	Bleacher seating for 280						
	Hospitality room will be open to coaches and certified officials.						
	The Virginia Swim Shop will be open for swimming accessories and shopping.						
	Please inform swimmers and parents that spectator deck space may be extremely tight.						
	<ul> <li>Any help in reducing the number of spectators and their carry in possessions would be greatly appreciated.</li> </ul>						
	Swim bags should be placed under the seats.						
	No glass containers, smoking or alcohol is permitted in the pool area.						
FACILITY	The NOVA Aquatics Center has parking available.						
RULES:	<ul> <li>Additional parking is available in the lot next door, and in several lots one block east of the pool at the intersection of Gayton and Cambridge.</li> </ul>

	• <b>NORTH</b> – 95 South to 64 West to the Gaskins Road South exit. Then follow the directions above.						
	• WEST – 64 East to the Short Pump/Broad Street 250 West exit. Follow Broad Street (250 West) to Pump Rd. Take a left at that light. Follow Pump Rd. to Ridgefield Parkway (3rd light); take a right. Follow Ridgefield to Gayton Rd. (2 lights); take a left on to Gayton. Pool is less than ½ mile on your left.
