FACILITY:	50 Meter by 25 yard pool, lanes have non-turbulent lane lines, deck-anchored starting blocks and water depth of min. of 7.0 feet at the starting end. The race course will be set up to swim widths with the pool depth sloping from 7 to 17 feet.
	Colorado Timing System with color scoreboard and separate video board will be used.
	The competition course has not been certified in accordance with current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 104.2.2(C).

ELIGIBILITY:	Open to all USA Swimming athletes registered by the first day of the meet.
	No on deck USA Swimming athlete registration will be permitted
	Age on January 8, 2011 will determine age for the entire meet
DISABILITY SWIMMERS:	Athletes with a disability are welcomed and shall provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director.
	The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to the competition.
FORMAT:	All events will be timed finals
	There will only be one session per day.
	Swimmers will be scored according to IMX Points. The intent of this meet is to have swimmers complete either the IMX or IMR format for their respective age-group.
	8 & Under 25's will start from the turn end of the race course.
WARM-UPS:	Warm-up will begin at 10:00 am; competition starts at 11:00 am each day.
	 Warm-up times will be posted on www.h2okieaquatics.org no later than January 5, 2011 and emailed to the contact person of the participating clubs.
	 Depending on the number of entries, the meet director reserves the right to change the start time and format of warm-ups. Teams would be notified not later than Wednesday, January 5, 2010
ENTRIES:	DEADLINE FOR THE RECEIPT OF ENTRIES IS TUESDAY, DECEMBER 28, 2010
	 Entries must be submitted in short course yards times using Hy-Tek Team Manager and Commlink-2 software.
	Teams must submit entries as an e-mail attachment
	 A Team Manager printout of entries must be included or the meet checklist/summary sheet with the name, phone number, and email address of the person to contact in case of questions must accompany the entries, regardless of how they are submitted.
	"No Time" (NT) entries will be accepted. All entry times other than NT must have been achieved in USA Swimming sanctioned, approved, or observed competition.
	Proof of time must be submitted with entry for all distance events
	Swimmers may enter a maximum of 5 events per day.
	Entries will be processed in the order received and <u>accepted to</u> the greatest extent possible without exceeding the 4-hour/session timeline limit.
	The Meet Director reserves the right to limit entries in any events, if necessary, to prevent too lengthy a session. This may include combining heats and events, which actions may require

	reseeding.

	Payment must be received by Wednesday, January 5, 2011, for email entries. Payment must be included with all mailed entries.
	Failure to pay entry fees by this deadline could result in teams being barred from the meet.
AWARDS:	Individual events: Ribbons will be awarded for first through eighth place.
_	o 12 & Under events will be awarded by 8&U, 9, 10, 11, and 12 year old single age groups.
	 13 & Over events will be awarded by 13 and 14 yr old single age groups and 15 & Over age groups.
SEEDING:	All events 200 yds or less will be pre-seeded. All events 400 yds or longer will be deck seeded with a positive check-in as described below.
	Swimmers should report directly to the blocks for their events.
	Positive check-in will close 10 min prior to the end of warm-ups.
	SWIMMERS FAILING TO POSITIVELY CHECK-IN WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SWIM THE EVENT
	SWIMMERS WHO CHECK-IN AND FAIL TO SHOW UP TO SWIM THE EVENT WILL BE BARRED FROM SWIMMING THEIR NEXT EVENT.
	13 & over 500 free will be swum fastest to slowest in alternating heats of girls and boys
PENALTIES:	Penalties for entries using fraudulent and/or non-verifiable entry times:
	Swimmer shall be marked as exhibition for the event entered illegally and the event shall be re-scored and awarded.
	Club may be fined \$100 for each offense, and a record of such offenses shall be kept and published as part of the official meet results.
	Clubs entering swimmers not legally registered with United States Swimming by the first day of the meet may be fined \$100 per swimmer in each event so entered.
	If the swimmer is representing a club in competition, the fine will be levied on the Club. If the swimmer is unattached, the fine will be levied on the swimmer.
RULES:	The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply.
	Swimmers in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA-S coach must be certified by a USA-S coach as proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. Ensuring compliance is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian
	The overhead start procedure will be used at the discretion of the Referee.
	In accordance with VSI Policy, only those coaches who have current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do not possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

	500 Free swimmers will need to provide their own timer and lap counter.
GENERAL:	Spectator seating of approx 1200 is available above the swimming venue.
	Only swimmers, officials, and timers are allowed on deck.
	Swim and Tri swimwear will be in attendance for swimming related items.
	 Hospitality will be provided to certified USA swimming coaches and registered USA swimming officials only.
