	 Coach Times (CT) will be accepted for events in which a swimmer does not have a time of record. CT may not exceed a "BB" time. All entry times other than CT must have been achieved in 				
	 USA Swimming sanctioned, approved, or observed competition. Converted times are acceptable. "No Time" (NT) entries will not be accepted.

	 Swimmers may enter 2 individual events on Friday and a maximum of 4 individual events per session not to exceed 5 total events for the day on Saturday and Sunday. If a swimmer exceeds the maximum entries, the last event entered, by numerical order, will be dropped. 				
	 Senior 800 freestyle: Only the top 24 swimmers of each gender are guaranteed entry. Proof of time must be provided. 				
	 9-12 400 Freestyle: Only the top 32 swimmers of each gender are guaranteed entry. Proof of time must be provided.

PENALTIES:	Penalties for entries using fraudulent and/or non-verifiable entry times				
	Swimmer shall be marked as exhibition for the event entered illegally and the event shall be re-scored and awarded.				

	 Club may be fined \$100 for each offense, and a record of such offenses shall be kept and published as part of the official meet results.
	 Clubs entering swimmers not legally registered with USA Swimming by the first day of the meet may be fined \$100 per swimmer in each event so entered.
	 If the swimmer is representing a club in competition, the fine will be levied on the Club. If the swimmer is unattached, the fine will be levied on the swimmer.
