Entries will be processed in the order received and accepted to the greatest extent possible without exceeding the 4-hour/session timeline limit. The Meet Director reserves the right to limit entries in any events, if necessary, to prevent too lengthy a session. This may include combining heats and events, which actions may require reseeding. All swimmers 10 & Under must report to the Clerk of Course and they will be escorted to the • blocks from there. All swimmers 11 and older will report directly to the blocks for their events. PENALTIES: Penalties for entries using fraudulent and/or non-verifiable entry times: Swimmer shall be marked as exhibition for the event entered illegally and the event shall be re-scored and awarded. Club may be fined \$100 for each offense, and a record of such offenses shall be kept and published as part of the official meet results. Clubs entering swimmers not legally registered with USA Swimming by the first day of the meet may be fined \$100 per swimmer in each event so entered. If the swimmer is representing a club in competition, the fine will be levied on the Club. If the swimmer is unattached, the fine will be levied on the swimmer. **RULES:** The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply. All swimmers participating in the meet must be dive certified. Swimmers unaccompanied by a USA-S coach must be certified by a USA-S coach as proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. Ensuring compliance is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian. The overhead start procedure will be used at the discretion of the Referee.
