The Mark Bire start and the sight to use 0 or 10 lanes for continuous warm-up/warm-down.				
	The Meet Director reserves the right to use 9 or 10 lanes for competition should it be necessary to keep the sessions under 4 hours.				
	The Facility uses a Daktronics Automatic Timing System with a 10-lane scoreboard and Kiefer Wave Eater racing lane lines.				
	• The competition course has not been certified in accordance with current <i>USA Swimming Rules</i> and <i>Regulations</i> , Article 104.2.2C(4).

	No on deck Virginia Swimming athlete registration will be permitted.				
	Age on September 24, 2011 will determine age for the entire meet.				
DISABILITY SWIMMERS:	Athletes with a disability are welcomed and shall provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director.				
	The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to the competition.				
FORMAT:	All Swimmers will swim in the morning Session.				
	All events will be timed finals.				
WARM-UP:	Morning sessions: Warm-ups at 7:30 AM; competition starts at 8:30 AM				
	Lane assignment and warm-up times for individual clubs will be posted on the WAC website (http://www.swimwac.com) no later than Wednesday September 21, 2011 and will also be emailed to the contact person of the participating clubs.				
	If the morning session runs late, afternoon warm-ups will begin immediately after the morning session ends.				
	Depending on the number of entries, the meet director reserves the right to change the start time and format of warm-ups. Teams would be notified not later than Wednesday September 21, 2011				
ENTRIES:	DEADLINE FOR THE RECEIPT OF ENTRIES IS SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 18, 2011				
	Entries must be submitted in Short Course Yards times using Hy-Tek Team Manager and Commlink-2 software, or on a VSI master entry sheet.				
	Teams submit entries via e-mail				
	A Team Manager printout of entries must be included or the meet checklist/summary sheet with the name of the person to contact in case of questions must accompany the entries, regardless of how they are submitted.				
	Coach Times (CT) and "No Time" (NT) entries will be accepted for events in which a swimmer does not have a time of record. CT may not exceed a "BB" time. All entry times other than CT must have been achieved in USA Swimming sanctioned, approved, or observed competition.				
	Swimmers may enter a maximum of 4 individual events and 1 relay event per day.				

	Relay teams must be designated A, B, C, etc., if more than one per club is entered per event.							
	The Mixed relays will consist of 2 Male & 2 Female Swimmers.							
	• Entries will be processed in the order received and <u>accepted to</u> the greatest extent possible without exceeding the 4-hour/session timeline limit.							
	 The Meet Director reserves the right to limit entries in any events, if necessary, to prevent lengthy a session. This may include combining heats and events, which actions may require reseeding.

SEEDING:	All events, except events will be pre-seeded. All Swimmers about dispatch to the blocks for their event.

	Swimmer shall be marked as exhibition for the event entered illegally and the event shall be re-scored and awarded.							
	 Club may be fined \$100 for each offense, and a record of such offenses shall be kept and published as part of the official meet results. 							
	 Clubs entering swimmers not legally registered with USA Swimming by the first day of the meet may be fined \$100 per swimmer in each event so entered. 							
	If the swimmer is representing a club in competition, the fine will be levied on the Club. If the swimmer is unattached, the fine will be levied on the swimmer.							
RULES:	The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply.							
	All swimmers participating in the meet must be dive certified.							
	 Swimmers unaccompanied by a USA-S coach must be certified by a USA-S coach as proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. 							
	 Ensuring compliance is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian. 							
	The overhead start procedure will be used for all Sessions.							
	In accordance with VSI Policy, only those coaches who have current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet							
	 Coaches with valid USA Swimming credentials but are unable to provide them upon request will be issued temporary credentials by the meet director 							
	Coaches with expired or non-current credentials will be required to leave the deck area

SAFETY:	Virginia Swimming Meet Safety Procedures will be in effect.						
TIMERS:	Clubs will be required to provide timers in proportion to the number of swimmers they have entered in each session.						
	The number of timers required per club and their lane assignments will be posted on the WAC website (http://www.swimwac.com) no later than Wednesday September 21, 2011, and will also be emailed to the contact person of each of the individual clubs.						
GENERAL:	Hospitality will be provided for coaches and officials.						
	Meet Programs will be sold.						
FACILITY RULES:	PLEASE READ THOROUGHLY. RULES WILL BE ENFORCED BY MEET MARSHALL, AQUATIC CENTER STAFF AND THE FORT EUSTIS FIRE MARSHALL.						
	FORT EUSTIS AUTOMOBILE ACCESS: DRIVERS LICENSE, AUTOMOBILE REGISTRATION, AND PROOF OF INSURANCE ARE REQUIRED TO ENTER FORT EUSTIS.						
	Swimmer/Spectator Conduct: Each club is responsible for supervising the conduct of its swimmers/spectators. Any swimmer/spectator that violates Aquatic Center rules, posted at the pool and in the meet program, will be disqualified from the meet and escorted from the facility.						
	 The Aquatic Center prohibits food of any kind in the pool area. Consumption of food is allowed in the lobby area and the spectator balcony. Permissible beverages, sports drinks and water, must be in closed plastic containers. 						
	Deck Access: Access to the competition pool deck will be strictly controlled. Swimmers, coaches, officials and event staff only will be permitted on the deck during warm-ups and the competition.						
	SWIMMERS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED IN THE BALCONY AREA. THE BALCONY SEATING AREA WILL BE FOR SPECTATORS ONLY. SWIMMERS MUST STAY ON THE COMPETITION POOL DECK.						
	The Adventure Pool side of the building WILL be available for seating on Friday, Saturday and Sunday.						
DIRECTIONS:	From I-64 take exit 250(Ft. Eustis Blvd.) towards Ft. Eustis. Go 4 blocks past the security gate and pass through the circular intersection. Turn right at the first Street (Tyler Road) past the circular intersection. The Aquatic Center is the building on the left. If the parking lot is full. Additional parking is 100 yards ahead on Tyler Road.
