ELIGIBILITY:	Open to all Virginia Swimming athletes and those by invitation registered by the first day of the meet		
	No on deck Virginia Swimming athlete registration will be permitted		
	Age on March 16, 2013 will determine age for the entire meet.		
DISABILTY SWIMMERS:	Athletes with a disability are welcomed and shall provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director.		
	The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to the competition.		
FORMAT:	Swimmers 11 years and younger will swim on Saturday morning.		
	Swimmers 12 years and older will swim on Saturday afternoon.		
	Il events will be timed finals		
	All 25 yard events will start from the turn end of the pool		
WARM-UP:	Saturday Morning session: Warm-ups at 7:30 am; competition starts no earlier than 8:40 am.		
	Saturday Afternoon session : Warm ups no earlier than 11:30 am; competition starts no earlier 12:40 pm		
	<ul> <li>Lane assignment and warm-up times for individual clubs will be posted on the BASS website         <u>www.BASS-Swim.org</u> no later than March 13, 2013, and will also be emailed to the contact person         of the participating clubs.     </li> </ul>		
	If any session runs late, the next session warm-ups will begin immediately upon it's conclusion.		
ENTRIES:	DEADLINE FOR THE RECEIPT OF ENTRIES IS WEDNESDAY, MARCH 6, 2013		
	• Entries must be submitted in short course yard times using Hy-Tek Team Manager and Commlink-2 software, or on a VSI master entry sheet.		
	Teams submit entries via e-mail		
	<ul> <li>A Team Manager printout of entries must be included or the meet checklist/summary sheet with the name of the person to contact in case of questions must accompany the entries, regardless of how they are submitted.</li> </ul>		
	Coach's Times (CT) will be accepted for events in which a swimmer does not have a time of record. CT may not exceed a "BB" time. All entry times other than CT must have been achieved in USA Swimming sanctioned, approved, or observed competition.		
	"No Time" (NT) entries will not be accepted.		
	Swimmers may enter a maximum of 4 individual events and 1 relay event per session.		
	Relay teams must be designated A, B, C, etc., if more than one per club is entered per event.		
	Entries will be processed in the order received and <u>accepted to</u> the greatest extent possible

	The Meet Director reserves the right to limit entries in any events, if necessary, to prevent too lengthy a session. This may include combining heats and events, which actions may require		
	reseeding.

	Payment must be received by March 12, 2013 for all entries. Failure to pay entry fees by this deadline could result in teams being barred from the meet. IMPORTANT: If entries are sent via		
	IMPORTANT: If payment is sent via Express Mail/FedEx/Airborne/UPS/etc., please ensure that a		
	signature is NOT required for delivery as this will delay the acceptance of your entries.		
AWARDS:	Individual events: Ribbons will be awarded for first through sixth place.		
	<ul> <li>12 &amp; over individual events will be given separate awards for 12-13, 14-15, and 16 &amp; over age</li> </ul>		
	groups.		
	<ul> <li>11 &amp; under individual events will be given separate awards for 10-11, 8-9, and 7 &amp; under age groups.</li> </ul>		
	8 & under individual events will be given separate awards for 7-8 and 6&U age groups.		
	<ul> <li>Heat winner ribbons will be awarded for all 8 &amp; under individual events.</li> </ul>		
	Relay events: Ribbons will be awarded for first through fourth place.		
SEEDING:	All events will be pre-seeded.		
	All 11 & younger swimmers must report to the Clerk of Course and they will be brought to the		
	blocks from there.		
	All swimmers 12 and older swimmers should report directly to the blocks for their events.		
PENALTIES:	Penalties for entries using fraudulent and/or non-verifiable entry times:		
	<ul> <li>Swimmer shall be marked as exhibition for the event entered illegally and the event shall be re-scored and awarded.</li> </ul>		
	Club may be fined \$100 for each offense, and a record of such offenses shall be kept and published as part of the official meet results.		
	Clubs entering swimmers not legally registered with USA Swimming by the first day of the meet may be fined \$100 per swimmer in each event so entered.		
	If the swimmer is representing a club in competition, the fine will be levied on the Club. If the swimmer is unattached, the fine will be levied on the swimmer.		
RULES:	The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply.		
	All swimmers participating in the meet must be dive certified.		
	<ul> <li>Swimmers unaccompanied by a USA-S coach must be certified by a USA-S coach as proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water.</li> </ul>		
	<ul> <li>Ensuring compliance is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian.</li> </ul>		
	The overhead start procedure will be used for the afternoon sessions, and may be used for the morning sessions at the discretion of the Referee.		
	Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. In addition, photography behind the blocks is not permitted.		
	Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is strongly discouraged.		
	In accordance with VSI Policy, only those coaches who have current, valid USA Swimming		

	credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet		
	<ul> <li>Coaches who have valid USA Swimming credentials but who are unable to provide them upon</li> </ul>		
	request will be issued temporary credentials by the meet director		
	Coaches with expired or non-current credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

	Officials at all positions will be required for this meet.		
	Team Officials Chairpersons should submit the names and session availability of certified officials,

	Officials will meet in the Lobby Area one minutes before the start of each session.		
SAFETY:	Virginia Swimming Meet Safety Procedures will be in effect.		
TIMERS:	Clubs will be required to provide timers in proportion to the number of swimmers they have entered		
	in each session.		
	The number of timers required per club and their lane assignments will be emailed to the contact person of each of the individual clubs no later than March 13, 2013.		
GENERAL:	Swimmer/Spectator Conduct: Each club is responsible for supervising the conduct of its swimmers/spectators.		
	Heat sheets will be available for sale.		
	• Concessions: There will be a variety of refreshments offered by the BASS Swim Team; Breakfast and lunch items will be available		
	Swim Supplies & Apparel: Sportfair will provide swimming supplies & apparel during the meet.		
FACILITY	Certain areas will be marked off limits. Please obey the rules.		
RULES:	No glass or smoking is permitted in the facility.		
	Please be courteous in sharing the locker rooms and bathrooms by keeping them neat.		
	No food or drinks in the pool or lobby area. All food and drinks must be kept in the gym.		
	<ul> <li>Please park in designated areas at the direction of parking attendants. There is very limited parking. Please carpool if possible. PLEASE DO NOT PARK ON THE GRASS.</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>Woodberry Forest School is located on Rt. 15, 12 miles south of the intersection of Rt. 15 and Rt.</li> <li>29. Turn into Woodberry at Rt. 622 (there are signs designating the school). Once you pass the guard house the Barbee Center is the first building on the left.</li> </ul>		
	• FROM THE NORTH: Take Rt. 29S to Rt. 15S. Turn left into Woodberry after 12 miles on Rt. 622.		
	• FROM THE EAST: Take Rt. 3W to Rt. 20S to Rt. 15N. Turn right into Woodberry 3 miles north of Orange on Rt. 622.		
	• FROM THE SOUTH: Take 29N to Rt.230E to Rt. 15N. Turn right into Woodberry after 1 mile on RT.622.
