	<ul> <li>Indoor 8 lane 50 meter x 25 yard pool, has 9 ft. wide lanes with non-turbulent lane lines. Pool depth of 7'7" at the sides and 8'2" in the center. Competition course is swum bulkhead to bulkhead.</li> </ul>							
	<ul> <li>Omega starting blocks, CTS6 with automatic and semi-automatic timing, backup Dolphin wireless stopwatches. Full color LED scoreboard will be used.</li> </ul>							
	• The competition course has been certified in accordance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 104.2.2C(4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming and the Poseidon Offices.

ELIGIBILITY:	Open to all USA Swimming registered athletes from the following teams: BAC, BASS, MACH, MAKOS, PSDN, SNOW, TIDE and WAC registered before the first day of the meet.							
	<ul> <li>Invited teams will be limited to 150 swimmers. If your team is NOT an invited team and wish to be considered for entry into this meet, please contact Marla Shreve, admin@poseidonswimming.com</li> </ul>							
	No on-deck USA Swimming athlete registration will be permitted.							
	• 13 & older swimmers must have a BB time or faster in each event entered, except for the host team which will have no time qualification. The 15-16 time standard will be used for 15 and older swimmers. 12 and younger swimmers will have no time qualifications.							
	2013-2016 NAG time standards are in effect.							
	Age on June 28, 2013 will determine age for the entire meet.							
DISABILITY SWIMMERS:	Athletes with a disability are welcomed and shall provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director.							
	• The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to the competition.							
FORMAT:	• All 13 & older swimmers will swim in the morning preliminary session with finals in the evening.							
	<ul> <li>The top 16 13-14 swimmers and top 24 15 &amp; older swimmers will swim the finals session</li> </ul>							
	<ul> <li>800 Freestyle and the 1500 Freestyle will be timed final events and will be limited to 4 heats, with 3 heats swum in prelims and fastest heat of 13 &amp; Older swimmers swum in finals.</li> </ul>							
	• All 12 & younger swimmers will swim in the afternoon session. Events in this session are timed finals.							
	Event #8 and 59 have been intentionally omitted.							
WARM-UP:	Morning sessions: Warm-ups at 7:00 AM competition starts at 8:00 AM							

	• Afternoon sessions: Warm-ups not before 12:30 PM; competition starts not before 1:30 PM.
	• Finals sessions: Warm-ups 5:30 PM, competition starts at 6:30 PM.
	<ul> <li>Lane assignment and warm-up times for individual clubs will be posted on the Poseidon website no later than Tuesday, June 25, 2013, and will also be emailed to the contact person of the participating clubs.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>If the morning session runs late, afternoon warm-ups will begin immediately after the morning session ends.</li> </ul>
ENTRIES:	DEADLINE FOR THE RECEIPT OF ENTRIES IS THURSDAY, JUNE 20, 2013.
	<ul> <li>Entries must be submitted in long course meter times using Hy-Tek Team Manager and Commlink-2 software, or on a VSI master entry sheet.</li> </ul>
	Teams will submit entries via email.
	<ul> <li>A Team Manager printout of entries must be included or the meet checklist/summary sheet with the name of the person to contact in case of questions must accompany the entries, regardless of how they are submitted.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>For 12 and younger swimmers, a Coach Time (CT) and "No Time" (NT) entries will be accepted for events in which a swimmer does not have a time of record.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>CT <u>must be slower than an "A" time</u>. All entry times other than CT must have been achieved in USA Swimming sanctioned, approved, or observed competition.</li> </ul>
	Swimmers may enter a maximum of 3 individual events a day.
	<ul> <li>Entries will be processed with invited teams processed first, then other teams from within the LSC and <u>accepted to</u> the greatest extent possible without exceeding the 4-hour/session timeline limit.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>The Meet Director reserves the right to limit entries in any events, if necessary, to prevent too lengthy a session. This may include combining heats and events, which actions may require reseeding.</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>Deck entries will be accepted in the order received for swimmers already entered in the meet, to the extent that open lanes are available. No additional heats will be added. Deck entries must be submitted to the Clerk-of-Course on the provided forms.</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>IMPORTANT: If payment is sent via Express Mail/FedEx/Airborne/UPS/etc., please ensure that a signature is NOT required for delivery as this will delay the receipt of your entries.</li> </ul>
AWARDS:	Individual events: Ribbons will be awarded for first through eighth place
	<ul> <li>13 &amp; Over events will be given separate awards for 13-14 and Open age groups.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>10 &amp; Under events will be given separate awards for 9-10 and 8 &amp; Under age groups.</li> </ul>
SEEDING:	<ul> <li>All events except those 400 m in length or longer will be pre-seeded. Swimmers will report directly to the blocks for these events.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Deck seeded events include, event # 1-2 (Open 400 Free), 7 (Women Open 800 Free), 27-28 (Open 400 IM), 60 (Men 1500 Free), 75-78 (12&amp;U 400 Free). These events are highlighted on the order of events page and will require a positive check-in to swim.</li> </ul>
	Positive check-in for each session will close 30 minutes before the session start.
	• SWIMMERS FAILING TO POSITIVELY CHECK-IN WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SWIM THE EVENT.
	12 & Under events will be swum as timed finals.

	13-14 and Open events will be swum together in prelims.								
	<ul> <li>13-14 and Open events will be swdin together in prenins.</li> <li>13-14 will swim an A &amp; B final and Open will swim an A, B, and C final, except for the</li> </ul>								
	women's 800 Freestyle and the men's 1500 Freestyle.								
	<ul> <li>Event 7, Women's 800 Freestyle and Event 60 Men's 1500 Freestyle will be limited to 4 heats, with 3 heats in prelims, swum fastest to slowest. The fastest heat of each event will be swum in finals.</li> </ul>								
PENALTIES:	Penalties for entries using fraudulent and/or non-verifiable entry times:								
	<ul> <li>Swimmer shall be marked as exhibition for the event entered illegally and the event sha be re-scored and awarded.</li> </ul>								
	<ul> <li>Club may be fined \$100 for each offense, and a record of such offenses hall be kept and published as part of the official meet results.</li> </ul>								
	• Clubs entering swimmers not legally registered with USA Swimming by the first day of the meet may be fined \$100 per swimmer in each event so entered.								
	• If the swimmer is representing a club in competition, the fine will be levied on the Club. If the swimmer is unattached, the fine will be levied on the swimmer.								
RULES:	The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply.								
	All swimmers participating in the meet must be dive certified.								
	<ul> <li>Swimmers unaccompanied by a USA-S coach must be certified by a USA-S coach as proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water.</li> </ul>								
	<ul> <li>Ensuring compliance is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian.</li> </ul>								
	• The overhead start procedure may be used for the all sessions at the discretion of the Meet Referee. Chase starts may also be used at the discretion of the Meet Referee.								
	• The scratch procedures listed in the current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 207.11.6, sections D and E only will be in effect and modified as follows: The scratch rule regarding finals will apply to all heats (final, consolation, and bonus), of all 13 & over events, excluding Event #1-2 (Open 400 Free), 7 (Women Open 800 Free), 27-28 (Open 400 IM), 60 (Men Open 1500 Free), and 75-78 (12&U 400 Free).								
	<ul> <li>Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. In addition, photography behind the blocks is <u>not permitted</u>.</li> </ul>								
	• Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is strongly discouraged.								
	<ul> <li>In accordance with VSI Policy, only those coaches who have current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet</li> </ul>								
	<ul> <li>Coaches with valid USA Swimming credentials but are unable to provide them upon request will be issued temporary credentials by the meet director</li> </ul>								
	<ul> <li>Coaches with expired or non-current credentials will be required to leave the deck area.</li> </ul>								
	• No VSI non-athlete member in good standing may be barred from participating in the meet as an official as certified.

	• Officials briefing will be one hour prior to the start of the meet in the Hospitality room.

TIMERS:	<ul> <li>Clubs may be required to provide timers in proportion to the number of swimmers they have entered in each session. Swimmers must provider their own timers for the event #7 (Women Open 800 Free) and 60 (Men Open 1500 Free).</li> </ul>
