Officiating Orientation Clinics for Beginning Stroke & Turn, Beginning Administrative, and Experienced YMCA officiating

Beginning Stroke & Turn – orientation clinic for new stroke / turn officials. Learn the basics of officiating, stroke mechanics, structure of Virginia Swimming, and more! After you take this clinic you can begin your apprenticeship as a stroke & turn official. Clinic is at 1:00 pm on 9/18 and will last until 3:30 pm. Beginning Administrative – also called “dry deck” because you will stay dry performing the functions of timing judge, recorder (computer operator) or CTS (timing equipment operator). If you would like to be part of a team and enjoy working with numbers, computers, or timing equipment, this clinic will prepare you to begin your apprenticeship as a TJ, Recorder, or CTS operator. The same clinic acts as the introduction for any/all of the above positions. Clinic is at 3:30 pm on 9/18 and will last until 5:00 pm. Level II YMCA Official – this clinic is designed for those who have at least 1 year of experience as either a YMCA official or a USA-S official and would like to be certified as a YMCA Level II official. Y Level II officials act as starters and referees in addition to acting as Stroke and Turn judges. Each YMCA closed meet needs to have at least 2 Y Level II officials in order to be approved, so Level II officials are a necessity for any YMCA team. Clinic is \$45. - Purpose:** This course is designed to certify new officials and re-certify existing officials for the YMCA of the USA's competitive swimming programs. The clinic will prepare participants to act in the capacities of Referee, Starter, and Chief Judge.
- Prerequisites:** Minimum Age: 21 years old. Associated with a recognized YMCA swim team. Approval of YMCA Executive Director or his/her designee. For new Level II Officials: candidates must have at least one year as a YMCA Level 1 Official and proof of officiating a minimum of 8 meet sessions over the last year. Current USA-Swimming officials may take Level II course, without first attending a Level I clinic, if they have been fully certified for at least one year and have worked at least 8 meet sessions as a fully certified official (apprentice sessions do not count). For re-certification as a Level II Official: must have worked at least 12 meet sessions as a certified official during the previous 3-year certification period.
