Applications to officiate at this year's national meets have been posted. Even though the deadline for applications has passed for the U.S. Open Championships and the Speedo Junior National Championships in Minneapolis, MN, we are short officials for both meets and would like to have as complete a deck as possible. The Online Testing Sub-Committee has completed updating all tests and all questions. **Effective immediately** you may begin taking the Online Tests using the **2008** Rules and Regulations handbook. FINA News. The were some open water rule changes approved at the recent extraordinary congress in Manchester, England but there weren't any changes to the rule book for pool swimming. The next FINA congress will be held in conjunction with the FINA World Championships in Rome next summer.

USA-S Rules. The Rules & Regulations Committee met in early June to review all the rule changes submitted by members of the USA Swimming House of Delegates. The proposed changes will be posted on the USA-S website at least 75 days prior to the House of Delegates meeting in late September. The House of Delegates meeting will be in Atlanta, GA this year.

New Meet. Mark Schubert announced that a new Junior Short Course Championship meet, to be held in Austin, Texas on the weekend of December 11-14 was accepted by the BOD. Details and the application to officiate are posted on the USA-S web site. *Click here* for applications.

Pool Measurement: One of the responsibilities of the meet referee is to make sure the pool meets the requirements as prescribed in the rule book. One of these requirements is the pool length. Please make sure that the facility has a certification of the pool length or, in a pool with a moveable bulkhead, that you have verified that the bulkhead is in the proper position and that the pool is the proper length.
