

## Responsibilities of the Administrative Officiating Positions (As it relates to determining the official time)

Official	Do's	Don'ts
Referee	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Inform the Timing Judge which type of timing adjustment is to be used at the meet</li> <li>• Inform the Timing Judge of the range of timing adjustments that they can make without consulting the Referee</li> <li>• Inform the administrative team of any special instructions</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Does <i>not</i> forget or ignore the administrative aspects of the meet</li> </ul>
Timing Equipment Operator	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ensures that timing equipment starts on starting signal; if not, performs manual start and notes "manual start" on print out</li> <li>• Notes "late touch" <i>when observed</i></li> <li>• Notes "early pad" <i>when observed</i> (i.e. electronic short, stepped on by timer/swimmer)</li> <li>• Notifies Referee of timers that appear to be having "difficulties"</li> <li>• Notifies Referee of buttons/pads that aren't functioning correctly</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Does <i>not</i> determine the official time</li> <li>• Does <i>not</i> "scratch through" any data on the print out</li> </ul>
Timing Judge	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Determines the official time under the direction of the Referee (102.16.3.E)</li> <li>• Discusses with Referee how timing adjustments are to be made (session average, vertical, horizontal, etc.)</li> <li>• Determines when the Referee requires notification and when independent judgment is acceptable</li> <li>• Obtains additional data as required (order of finish, coaches times)</li> <li>• Notes "DQ" as required on print out</li> <li>• Determines timing adjustment to be made when the secondary or tertiary time is being taken as the official time (can delegate operating parameters to the Recorder)</li> <li>• Notes Timers that appear to be having "difficulties", alerts Referee, and may talk to them directly</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Does <i>not</i> operate independently of Referee</li> <li>• Does <i>not</i> operate contrary to instructions from the Referee</li> </ul>
Recorder	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Record the official time as determined by the Timing Judge/Referee</li> <li>• Assist Timing Judge with timing adjustment calculations via software</li> <li>• Can ask the Timing Judge "if that's what your really meant to do" or suggest an alternative—but the Timing Judge/Referee decision is ultimately final</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Does <i>not</i> determine the official time, even if the Recorder is also a certified Timing Judge (Unless the Recorder is also functioning as the Timing Judge for the session)</li> </ul>
