FACILITY:	The 50 Meter Competition Pool has a depth of 7 Feet and 7 inches at the sides and 8 Feet 2 inches in the center. Competition lanes are a minimum of 9 feet wide.				
	 The 50-Meter competition pool with bulkhead offers two 25 yard competition pools with a depth of seven feet and seven inches at the sides and eight feet two inches in the center. Competition lanes are a minimum of 9 feet wide swum wall to bulkhead. 				
	This meet will be swum in the 50 Meter course.				
	Warm-up and warm-down lanes will be available for 5 minutes after every cycle of events. Coaches will monitor to ensure that Social Distancing will be enforced				
	Non-Turbulent Lane Markers will be used.				
	Omega Starting Blocks, CTS6 with automatic and semi-automatic timing, backup Dolphin wireless stopwatches will be used.				
	The Spectator seating will be marked for Social Distancing. We will be using every other row of seats with colored tape marking the spot to sit 10 feet apart.				
	The competition course has been certified in accordance with current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 104.2.2C(4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming.

ELIGIBILITY:	 Open to all Virginia Swimming athletes from Williamsburg Aquatic Club registered before the first day of the Meet. No on deck Virginia Swimming athlete registration will be permitted. 2017-2020 NAG time standards are in effect. (Use in announcements when appropriate) 					
DIO A DIL ITY	Age on July 26 th will determine age for the entire meet.					
DISABILITY SWIMMERS:	Athletes with a disability are welcome and shall provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director.					
	The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to the competition.					
FORMAT:	All swimmers will swim in a single session.					
	All events will be timed finals.					
	The layout of the Timers and the Clerk of Course will follow the format shown on the diagram that is included.					
WARM-UP:	Morning session: Warm-ups will start at 8:00 A.M; competition starts at 8:45 A.M.					
	Warm-up times for the WAC Swimmers will be posted on the Williamsburg Aquatic Club website no later than Tuesday July 21st and will also be emailed to the parents of the WAC Club.					
ENTRIES:	DEADLINE FOR THE RECEIPT OF ENTRIES IS 12:00 P.M. Sunday July 19th.					
	Entries must be submitted on the WAC website by the deadline date.					
	"No Time" (NT) entries will be accepted.					
	 Coach Times (CT) will be accepted for events in which a swimmer does not have a time of record. CT <u>must be slower than an "A" time</u>. All entry times other than CT must have be achieved in USA Swimming sanctioned, approved, or observed competition. 					
	Swimmers may enter a maximum of 4 individual event for the Meet.					
	The Meet Director reserves the right to limit entries in any events. This may include combining heats and events, which may require reseeding.					
	All Entries will be submitted through the WAC Team Unify Website.					
FEES:	Individual events: \$5.00 per Event Swimmer surcharge: \$2.50 per person participating in the Meet in any capacity.					
	Fees charges will be emailed to the individual Swimming Families.					
SEEDING:	All events will be pre-seeded.					
	Clerk of Course will be provided for all events based on the COVID rules set up by the Facility and by Virginia Swimming.					
	No Events will require a positive check-in.					
	All Events will be swum Slowest to Fastest.					
AWARDS:	Individual events: Ribbons will be awarded for first through 8th place. 12.8 Over events will be given concrete awards for 12.14 and 15.8 Over any ground.					
	 13 & Over events will be given separate awards for 13-14 and 15 & Over age groups. 11 & Over events will be given separate awards for 11-12, 13-14, and 15 & Over age 					
	groups.					
	 12 & Under events will be given separate awards for 11-12, 9-10 and 8 & Under age groups. 					
PENALTIES:	A fine of up to \$100 per event may be assessed for any illegal participation in the meet. Illegal participation is defined as					
	 Entries using fraudulent or non-verifiable times. Athlete competed in the incorrect age group. Athlete is not registered with USA Swimming prior to the first day of the meet. 					
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	If the swimmer is representing a club in competition, the fine will be levied on the Club. If the swimmer is unattached, the fine will be levied on the swimmer.				
	Any event in which an athlete participated illegally will be rescored and re-awarded.				
RULES:	Athletes MUST arrive in their suits on. Locker Rooms will not be available.				
	 All individuals entering the facility will be expected to answer Virginia Department of Health screening questions to include temperature screening. 				
	Coaches, officials and spectators must wear masks.				
	The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations including the Minor Athlete Abuse Protection Policy will govern this meet.				
	 Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA-S member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer' legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. 				
	Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present without written USA Swimming approval				
	 Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changareas, rest rooms or locker rooms. In addition, photography behind the blocks is not per 				
	Changing, in whole or in part, into or out of swimsuit when wearing just one suit in an area other than in a locker room, bathroom, or other space designated for changing is PROHIBITED.				
	 An athlete suspected of sustaining a concussion or exhibiting signs of a concussion, will immediately be removed from competition and shall not return to competition that day. The athlete may return to competition on a subsequent day, but only with a release authorization signed by a licensed healthcare provider. 				
	In accordance with VSI best practices, all swimmers should shower before entering the pool.				
	In accordance with VSI Policy, only those coaches who have current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches with expired or non-current credentials will be required to leave the deck area.
