Competition lanes are a minimum of 9 feet wide swum wall to bulkhead. 7 lanes will be used for competition with 2 warm-up/warm-down additional lanes available but meet director reserves the right to run up to 10 lanes. Non-Turbulent Lane Markers Spectrum Starting Blocks, CTS6 with automatic and semi-automatic timing, backup Dolphin wireless stopwatches. The WISC provides 1 indoor pool and wireless internet. Spectator seating for 400-500. The competition course has not been certified in accordance with current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 104.2.2C(4) | | |

| ELIGIBILITY: | Open to all USA Swimming athletes from 757swim, SEVA, and Poseidon registered before the first day of the meet. No on-deck USA Swimming athlete registration will be permitted. Age on October 26th, 2019 will determine age for the entire meet. | | |
| DISABILITY SWIMMERS: | Athletes with a disability are welcome and shall provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director. The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to the competition. | | |
| FORMAT: | All 12 & Under swimmers will swim in the AM session. All 13 & Over swimmers will swim in the PM session. All events will be timed finals. Sunday Distance Session will start 15 minutes after the conclusion of the afternoon session. | | |

| | Coach Time (CT) and "No Time" (NT) entries will be accepted for events in which a swimmer does not have a time of record. CT <u>must be slower than an "A" time</u>. All entry times other than CT must have been achieved in USA Swimming sanctioned, approved, or observed competition. | | |
| | Swimmers may enter up to 5 individual events each day. Entries will be processed in the order received and accepted to the greatest extent possible without exceeding the 4-hour/session timeline limit.
