

	The competition course has not been certified in accordance with current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 104.2.2C (4).

ELIGIBILITY:	<ul> <li>Open to all 10 and under USA Swimming athletes registered before the first day of the meet.</li> <li>No on-deck USA Swimming athlete registration will be permitted.</li> <li>Age on January 25<sup>th</sup>, 2020 will determine age for the meet.</li> </ul>	
DISABILITY SWIMMERS:	Athletes with a disability are welcome and shall provide notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director.	
	The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to the competition.	
FORMAT:	All events will be timed finals.	
WARM-UP:	<ul> <li>Warm-ups: 8:00-8:45AM. Meet Start 9:00 AM.</li> <li>Lane assignments and warm up times for individual clubs will be posted on the CCA website no later than Tuesday, January 21, 2020 and will also be emailed to the contact person of the participating clubs.</li> </ul>	
ENTRIES:	DEADLINE FOR THE RECEIPT OF ENTRIES IS TUESDAY January 14th, 2020	
	Entries must be submitted in short course times using Hy-Tek Team Manager and Commlink-2 software.	
	Teams submit entries via email.	
	A Team Manager printout of entries must be included or the meet checklist/summary sheet with the name of the person to contact in case of questions must accompany the entries, regardless of how they are submitted.	
	Coach Time (CT) and "No Time" (NT) entries will be accepted for events in which a swimmer does not have a time of record. CT must be slower than an "A" time. All entry times other than CT must have been achieved in USA Swimming sanctioned, approved, or observed competition.	
	Swimmers may enter a maximum of <i>4 individual events.</i>

	<ul> <li>Deck entries will be accepted in the order received for swimmers already entered in the meet, to the extent that open lanes are available. No additional heats will be added. Deck entries must be submitted to the Administrative Official on the provided forms.</li> </ul>	

FEES:	<ul> <li>There will be a flat Swimmer Surcharge fee of \$20. No additional fees per event.</li> <li>Checks should be made payable to: CCA Marlins.</li> <li>Mail payment to: Attn: Amina Serir, 4254 Colonial Ave, Roanoke, VA 24018</li> <li>Payment must be received by Tuesday, January 21st, 2020. Failure to pay entry fees by this deadline could result in teams being barred from the meet.</li> <li>IMPORTANT: If payment is sent via Express Mail/FedEx/Airbourne/UPS, etc., please ensure that a signature is NOT required for delivery.</li> </ul>		
AWARDS:	There will be no awards given, heat winners will receive a rubber Ducky		
SEEDING:	All events will be pre-seeded		
PENALTIES:	<ul> <li>A fine of up to \$100 per event may be assessed for any illegal participation in the meet. Illegal participation is defined as</li> <li>Entries using fraudulent or non-verifiable times.</li> <li>Athlete competed in the incorrect age group.</li> <li>Athlete is not registered with USA Swimming prior to the first day of the meet.</li> <li>If the swimmer is representing a club in competition, the fine will be levied on the Club. If the swimmer is unattached, the fine will be levied on the swimmer.</li> <li>Any event in which an athlete participated illegally will be rescored and re-awarded.</li> </ul>		
RULES:	<ul> <li>The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Protection Policy, will govern this meet.</li> <li>All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (MAAPP) and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.</li> <li>Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USAS member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.</li> <li>Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present without written USA Swimming approval.</li> <li>Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. In addition, photography behind the blocks is not permitted.</li> <li>Changing, in whole or in part, into or out of swimsuit when wearing just one suit in an area other than in a locker room, bathroom, or other space designated for changing is PROHIBITED.</li> </ul>		
OFFICIALS:	<ul> <li>Any athlete suspected of sustaining a concussion or exhibiting signs of a concussion, will immediately be removed from competition and shall not return to competition that day. The athlete may return to competition on a subsequent day, but only with a release authorization signed by a licensed healthcare provider.</li> <li>In accordance with VSI Policy, only those coaches who have current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who have valid USA Swimming credentials but who are unable to provide them upon request will be issued temporary credentials by the meet director.
