	<ul> <li>Configured for 8-lane 25 yard for the competition portion of the pool with the depth being 14 feet at the start end and the 6 feet at the turn end swimming into a bulkhead]</li> </ul>			
	• 6 continuous warm-up / cool down lanes (4-6 feet in depth) in the non-competition portion of the pool			
	• The competition course has not been certified in accordance with current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 104.2.2C (4).

ELIGIBILITY:	Open to all SEVA swimmers already registered with Virginia Swimming/USA Swimming.			
	No on deck Virginia Swimming athlete registration will be permitted			
	Age on January 10, 2020 will determine age for the Inter-Squad Meet.			
DISABILITY SWIMMERS:	Athletes with a disability are welcome and shall provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director.			
	The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to the competition.			
FORMAT:	All events will be timed final.			
WARM-UP:	Warm-up: No earlier than 4:30 pm. Meet Starts: No earlier than 5:00 pm.			
ENTRIES:	Entry times must be submitted in short course yards for swimmers with a time of record			
	"No Time" (NT) entries will be accepted.			
	Swimmer may enter a maximum of 2 individual events.			
	The Meet Director reserves the right to limit entries in any events, if necessary, to prevent too lengthy a session. This- may include combining heats and events, which actions could require reseeding.			
FEES:	No Entry Fees will be charged			
SEEDING:	All events will be pre-seeded. A positive check-in will occur. A re-seed could be done for any event that would save time.			
AWARDS:	No awards will be given.			
PENALTIES:	A fine of up to \$100 per event may be assessed for any illegal participation in the meet. Illegal is defined as:			
	<ul> <li>Entries using fraudulent and/or non-verifiable times.</li> </ul>			
	<ul> <li>Athlete competes in the incorrect age groups.</li> </ul>			
	<ul> <li>Athlete is not registered with USA Swimming prior to the first day of the meet.</li> </ul>			
	<ul> <li>If the swimmer is representing a club in competition, the fine will be levied on the Club. If the swimmer is unattached, the fine will be levied on the swimmer.</li> </ul>			
RULES:				

	the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (MAAPP) and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.			
	Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USAS member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.			
,	<ul> <li>Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present without written USA Swimming approval.</li> </ul>			
	<ul> <li>Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. In addition, photography behind the blocks is <u>not permitted</u>.</li> </ul>			
	Changing, in whole or in part, into or out of swimsuits when wearing just one suit in an area other than a locker room, bathroom, or other space designed for changing is PROHIBITED.			
	<ul> <li>If is a Midtown Community Center requirement that ALL swimmers must shower before entering the pool.</li> </ul>			
	<ul> <li>An athlete suspected of sustaining a concussion or exhibiting signs of a concussion, will immedia be removed from competition and shall not return to competition that day. The athlete may return competition on a subsequent day, but only with a release authorization signed by a licensed healthcare provider.</li> </ul>			
	In accordance with VSI Policy, only those coaches who have current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches with expired or non-current credentials will be required to leave the deck area.
