	• The 50-Meter competition pool with bulkhead offers two 25 yard competition pools with a depth of seven feet and seven inches at the sides and eight feet two inches in the center. Competition lanes are a minimum of 9 feet wide swum wall to bulkhead.				
	This meet will be swum in the 25 yard course.

	Age on July 25 will determine age for the entire meet.

FORMAT:	All 13 and Over swimmers will swim in the morning session.			
	All 12 and Under swimmers will swim in the late morning/afternoon session.			
	All events will be timed finals.			
SCREENING, CHECK-IN and	• All athletes and parents need to report to the screening station upon arrival. Parents will receive a wrist band once they are screened. Athletes will be checked in for the meet.			
WARM-UP:	• SWIMMERS FAILING TO REPORT TO THE SCREENING STATION WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SWIM THE EVENT. MINOR ATHLETES WILL NEED TO REPORT TO THE SCREENING STATION WITH A PARENT OR GUARDIAN. PARENTS MAY SUBMIT THEIR ATHLETE'S SCREENING QUESTIONNAIRE PRIOR TO ARRIVAL BY EMAIL TO <u>HEALTHSCREENING@SWIMRICHMOND.ORG</u> JUST LIKE A NORMAL PRACTICE DAY.			
	• Morning session: Athlete screening and Check-in at 7:30-8:00AM under the tent in the front lawn of the facility. Warm-ups at 8:15-8:45, athletes will have assigned lanes and should wait to report to their assigned warm up lane until 8:10; competition starts at 9:00AM.			
	• Late morning/afternoon session: Athlete screening and check-in not before 11:30-12:00PM under the tent in the front lawn of the facility. Warm-ups at 12:15-12:45PM, athletes will have assigned lanes and should wait to report to their assigned warm up lane until 12:10; competition starts at 1:00PM.			
	<ul> <li>If the morning session runs late, afternoon check in will begin 30 minutes after conclusion of the morning session to give staff time to disinfect the facility.</li> </ul>			
ENTRIES:	DEADLINE FOR THE RECEIPT OF ENTRIES IS Saturday July 18th at noon.			
	• Swimmers may enter a maximum of <i>4 individual event(s)</i> .			
	• Entries will be processed in the order received and <u>accepted to</u> the greatest extent possible without exceeding the 4-hour/session timeline limit.			
	No deck entries will be accepted.

VIDEO SERVICE	• SwimRVA has installed a new video service in the main arena. The service will be available for the meet at no charge to SwimRVA families. Families will be able to stream the service on their smart phone or device from anywhere they have service! This will be a fantastic addition to our social distancing guidelines and allow for viewing the races from the outdoor seating areas or anywhere in the world!			
VIRGINIA PHASE THREE GUIDELINES ATHLETE &	<ul> <li>INSIDE SEATING: Spectators, athletes, coaches and officials not in the same household are also required to maintain 10 feet of social distance. Lastly, spectators, athletes, coaches and officials are required to wear a face mask at all times inside the venue when not swimming. (see map)</li> </ul>			
SPECTATOR SEATING AND REPORTING TO THE	<ul> <li>OUTSIDE SEATING (see map): Outside the venue the event is limited to 250 persons on the grass seating areas (see map). Spectators, athletes, coaches and officials not in the same household need to maintain 6 feet of social distance while outside the venue. 	<ul> <li>RESERVATIONS FOR INSIDE SEATING (see map): There are seating sections for up to four persons in the main arena. They must be reserved prior to the meet by emailing Kim Wiiki at kim.wiiki@swimrichmond.org. Indicate how many are in your group including your athlete(s). ONLY FAMILIES WHO RESERVED AN INDOOR LOCATION WILL HAVE ACCESS TO THE MEZZANINE.</li> </ul>				
	<ul> <li>REPORTING TO THE STARTING BLOCKS: SwimRVA will have speakers with the arena public address in the outdoor seating area. The announcer will announce heats and events. The announcer will also call athletes to the arena for their event three heats in front of their race. Athletes should report to the arena through the northeast entry doors and ready themselves in the corresponding location on the north wall. Heat in the water, next heat on deck at the northwest corner of the competition pool, second heat in the next wait zone, third heat in the next wait zone. It is the athlete's responsibility to report to the blocks and corresponding location when it is time to compete.</li> </ul>				
SEEDING:	Heat sheets will be emailed to all team members through Team Unify.				
	All events will be pre-seeded.				
	• SWIMMERS FAILING TO REPORT TO THE SCREENING STATION WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SWIM THE EVENT. MINOR ATHLETES WILL NEED TO REPORT TO THE SCREENING STATION WITH A PARENT OR GUARDIAN.				
AWARDS:	Awards will not be distributed. Scoring will be broken out by age group.				
PENALTIES:	• A fine of up to \$100 per event may be assessed for any illegal participation in the meet. Illegal participation is defined as				
	<ul> <li>Entries using fraudulent or non-verifiable times.</li> </ul>				
	<ul> <li>Athlete competed in the incorrect age group.</li> </ul>				
	<ul> <li>Athlete is not registered with USA Swimming prior to the first day of the meet.</li> </ul>				
	<ul> <li>If the swimmer is representing a club in competition, the fine will be levied on the Club. If the swimmer is unattached, the fine will be levied on the swimmer.</li> </ul>				
RULES:	<ul> <li>Any event in which an athlete participated illegally will be rescored and re-awarded.</li> <li>Athletes must arrive in their suits. Locker rooms will not be available.</li> </ul>				
	<ul> <li>All individuals entering the facility will be expected to answer Virginia Department of Health screening questions to include temperature screening to gain entry to mezzanine.</li> </ul>				
	• Lobby restrooms and Swim and Tri swim shop are open for anyone wearing a mask and able to answer Virginia Department of Health screening questions.				
	Coaches, officials, and spectators must wear masks.

	• All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (MAAPP) and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.				
	• Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA-S member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.				
	• Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present without written USA Swimming approval.				
	• Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. In addition, photography behind the blocks is <u>not permitted</u> .
